#### **(A) Thematic Talks**

**Purpose:** We are committed to equipping students with knowledge of global issues, such as poverty, extreme weather events and conflicts, which may seem distant from us yet are causing many vulnerable children in poor countries to suffer. With the vision to nurture global citizens of tomorrow, we welcome invitations from secondary schools for thematic talks (presented in English or Mandarin, duration 1 school session). Each talk is designed to bring global issues alive for students with the help of multimedia and stories of beneficiaries.

<b>I Wish I Can Return Home</b> (War and poverty)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Explore the connections of war and poverty in Ukraine, Afghanistan and Africa</li> <li>● Learn about how World Vision offers immediate assistance and long-term support to people affected by war</li> <li>● Encourage students to be peacemakers in the community</li> </ul>
<b>Water</b> (Water and sanitation)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Learn about water supply in Macau in comparison with those places in need</li> <li>● Learn how World Vision's projects in developing countries with examples</li> <li>● Encourage students to cherish our resources</li> </ul>

#### **(B) Educational and Fundraising Activities**

Activities	Content	Event Time
<b>School Famine Experiencing Workshop</b>	In such experiencing workshop, students are assigned to take part in different roles, e.g. refugees, and make choices, which help them understand lives of the needy in fragile areas. Students can reflect on daily lifestyle and values, and will be encouraged to pursue a simpler lifestyle. Duration for workshop will be around 2.5 hours. Students are encouraged to skip meal to donate for the needy. Besides, we can organise workshop or invite students to help arranging workshop so that they can learn through organising activities. <b>Red Packet Campaign</b>	During Chinese New Year, students are encouraged to donate a red packet to support children and families in need. The donation will help provide essential support for them.	Jan to Mar 2025
<b>World Vision Flag Day</b>	Students are encouraged to take part in our Flag Day to raise funds for children affected by hunger in developing countries.	22-23 Mar 2025
<b>Flag Day in School</b>	Teachers and students are welcome to arrange your own Flag Day selling in school to raise funds for children affected by hunger in developing countries.	To be assigned by school
