# **「守護脆弱孩子」計劃**的成果

### **Discover our Impact in Childhood Rescue**

在2024年,烏克蘭和敘利亞等地的衝 突持續,不僅威脅著脆弱孩子的生命, 也加劇了飢餓問題。現時全球七成的飢 餓人口生活在受戰事和暴力影響的地區。 而氣候變化引發的乾旱亦阻礙糧食生產, 進一步惡化脆弱孩子的成長環境。「守護 脆弱孩子」月捐計劃集合大家的捐款,在 環境脆弱的地區提供基本生活、營養及 生計援助,又向孩子提供心理及教育等 支援,讓他們得以重獲生機、重整生活 和重建未來。

In 2024, conflicts in places such as Ukraine and Syria continued, not only threatening the lives of vulnerable children, but also exacerbating the problem of hunger. Currently, 70% of the world's hungry people live in areas affected by war and violence. Droughts caused by climate change also hamper food production, further worsening the growing environment for vulnerable children. The "Childhood Rescue" monthly donation programme pools together donations to provide basic living, nutritional and livelihood assistance in environmentally fragile areas, while offering psychological and educational services to children, allowing them to survive, recover and build a future.

### 健康與營養項目 **Health and Nutrition Project**

宣明會在阿富汗的阿布卡馬里和卡迪斯等偏遠地 區開設健康中心,提供基本醫療保健、免疫接種 產前產後護理、營養篩檢和治療等服務。然而, 脆弱孩子仍然面臨著許多挑戰,包括大雪和降雨 造成約半年的道路堵塞,阻礙他們接受治療。為 了及時醫治患上急性營養不良的孩子,我們透過 「守護脆弱孩子」計劃的捐款,以先行預備所需 物資。

The Static Health Centres (SHCs) in Afghanistan are delivering critical health and nutrition services to the hard-to-reach areas of Abkamary and Qadis. The SHCs conducted regular operations to the project locations, offering essential health care, immunisation, antenatal and postnatal care, malnutrition screening and treatment. However, these vulnerable children still face many challenges like road blockages due to heavy snowfall and rainfall that hamper their access to treatment. To address the needs of acute malnourished children, we use the donations from Childhood Rescue to prepare for the necessary resources.

#### **Kitchen Gardening Project**

蘇丹爆發內亂後,瑪麗發現自己處境十分艱辛。 在逃離衝突時失去了丈夫,她只有帶著孩子逃至 南蘇丹,但由於缺乏棲身之所及資源,面臨著更 大的挑戰。為了建立穩定的收入來源,她與15名 同伴組成種植蔬菜小組。因著宣明會「家庭菜園 項目」的支持,能自給自足與變得喜樂感恩。

Mary found herself in challenging circumstances following the outbreak of civil unrest in Sudan. Having lost her husband while fleeing the conflict, she returned to South Sudan with her children, only to face further hardship due to the lack of accommodation and resources. Determined to create a sustainable solution, Mary joined forces with 15 other individuals to form a vegetable group. Empowered by the support and knowledge imparted by the World Vision team, Mary achieved self-sufficiency, a transformation that filled her with joy and gratitude.


Across the camp, 15-year-old Jana (right), attended World Vision's remedial and child protection sessions at a refugee camp in Jordan. She hoped to give back to her community. She and her 11 other peers decided to address the camp's most pressing issues on solid waste disposal. World Vision provided them with comprehensive training sessions on solid waste management, the twelve participating girls launched an awareness campaign to teach children how to sort waste and care for their surroundings. Jana says, "I used to be scared of speaking out, but now, I feel like a role model to these children. It's such an empowering feeling."



### **Discover our Impact in Disaster Responses**

「我們迅速回應」是宣明會的核心信念之一。當災難來襲時,飢餓、暴力、創傷,以及痛失親朋、家園、學校和安全感等,也會令兒童深受其害,甚至失去保護。因此,宣明會一直迅速回應各項自然災害及人道災難,從災難開始直至完成重建,協助家庭盡快恢復生計,兒童重拾日常生活。而對於持續多年的全球飢餓危機,我們亦繼續為飽受飢餓之苦的兒童及家庭提供緊急和長期援助。

"We are responsive" is one of World Vision's core values. When disaster strikes, children endure hunger, violence, trauma, and the loss of family, friends, homes, schools, and a sense of security. Therefore, World Vision responds swiftly to natural and humanitarian disasters, supporting communities from the onset of the crisis through to reconstruction, helping families regain their livelihoods and allowing children to resume their daily lives. In light of the ongoing global hunger crisis, we continue to provide both emergency and long-term assistance to children and families affected by hunger.

# 重點工作

**Work Highlights** 



2023年是糧食不安全狀況連續惡化的第5年。全球飢餓危機影響多達59個國家和地區的2.82億人,相對於2019年疫情仍未發生之前增加了1.45億人。而導致糧食危機加劇的主要原因,包括持續的衝突及極端天氣的影響。同時,經濟打擊亦進一步加劇糧食危機,導致全球數百萬人陷入飢餓的困境。宣明會在2024年繼續在受影響的非洲及中東等國家,協助受影響的兒童及家庭應對飢餓危機。

2023 marks the fifth consecutive year of worsening food insecurity. The global hunger crisis is affecting 282 million people across 59 countries and territories - an increase of 145 million people from 2019, prior to the COVID-19 pandemic. The primary drivers of this surge include ongoing conflicts and climate extremes. Along with economic shocks, these factors have created a complex web of challenges that exacerbate food crisis, pushing millions of people into acute hunger across the globe. World Vision continues to respond to the crisis in Africa and the Middle East, assisting children and families in tackling hunger crisis.

#### 阿富汗地震緊急救援

#### Afghanistan Earthquake Emergency Response

阿富汗西部社區在2023年10月7日,持續遭受 地震侵襲,受災人數高達27.5萬人,估計六至七 成為婦女及兒童。阿富汗經歷長達40多年的衝突, 加上2021年國際社會撤軍加劇其影響,引發經濟 崩潰。醫療保健服務嚴重不足,因氣候變化導致 的乾旱亦持續。阿富汗逾半數人口(2.370萬)需 要人道援助。宣明會在地震後迅速提供緊急援助, 但國家仍然需要持續支援以增強社區的抗逆力。

Communities in western Afghanistan were affected by a series of earthquakes, which began on 7 October 2023. Afghanistan has endured over four decades of conflict, the effects of which were exacerbated by the international withdrawal in 2021, triggering an economic collapse. Healthcare provision is critically inadequate while climate change-driven drought remains an enduring systemic challenge. Over 50% of the population (23.7 million) require humanitarian assistance. Besides the emergency support provided by World Vision after the earthquakes, the country still requires continual support to increase the resilience of communities.

#### 尼泊爾地震緊急救援 **Nepal Earthquake Emergency Response**

2023年11月3日,一場6.4級強烈地震襲擊尼泊爾 卡納利省的賈賈科特地區,造成該省154人死亡, 366人受傷。受災人數高達25萬人,26,557間 房屋完全損毀,災民流離失所、公共基礎設施遭受 嚴重破壞,區內焦慮和創傷後壓力症候群等精神健 康問題加劇。在事故發生後的12小時內,宣明會 已經展開緊急救援工作。誘過香港特別行政區政 府賑災基金的捐助,我們在賈賈科特地區提供緊 急援助,以濟災民的燃眉之急。

#### 中國水災救援 **China Flood Response**

自2023年7月下旬起,連續三次颱風帶來創紀錄 的降雨,引發中國華北和東北廣泛地區遭受洪澇 和山泥傾瀉影響。北京、河北、天津、黑龍江、 吉林和遼寧嚴重受災。根據國家應急管理部統計, 在2023年7月因洪水、山崩、山洪等災害造成 142人死亡。透過香港特別行政區政府賑災基金 的捐助,宣明會得以在吉林省吉林市和長春市為 受災者提供緊急援助。

Since late July 2023, northern and northeastern China had been struck by widespread flooding and landslides, caused by record rainfall from three successive typhoons. Beijing, Hebei, Tianjin, Heilongjiang, Jilin and Liaoning were among the regions most affected. According to the Ministry of Emergency Management, a total of 142 people nationwide lost their lives due to flooding, landslides and mountain torrents in July. With the funding from the Disaster Relief Fund of the HKSAR Government, World Vision was able to address emergency needs in Jilin City and Changchun City in Jilin Province.
