Long-term community development



- Help sponsored children, their families and community members
- Identify the root causes of poverty and particular needs of each community, mapping out and running a unique Area Programme (AP) alongside community members
- APs include works of various sectors, such as education, water, health, child protection and livelihoods, that can improve children's growth environment and empower community members to be resilient, that they would become self-sustainable and be free from the poverty trap

Immediate response to the needs of needy and families

- Respond immediately in conflicts and disasters
- Provide relief aid and other nescessities
- Revive livelihoods of the affected through rehabilitation



Within 72 hours: **Initial Response** 

- Deploy Rapid Response Teams to the affected areas and conduct assessment
- First batch of emergency supplies arrive



One to six weeks: **Emergency Response** 


- Provide food, hygiene kits, water, basic sanitation and other emergency aid items for families affected
- Provide shelter kits, tents and other temporary shelter materials



Six weeks to 12 months: Social and **Economic Recovery** 

- Establish child protection measures such as Child Friendly Spaces for children to release distress
- Restore healthcare services and education facilities
